

LINGUISTIC IMMERSION - ACTIVITY PROGRAMME COMMERCIAL VIDEO

Number of group members: Min. 2 people / Max. 4 people

Format: Video recording. You can record in different places or use pictures or powerpoint as a visual support for your project. Become a youtuber or a vlogger for one day to show and sell your commercial! ;)

Duration: Approximately 5 min

TOPIC:

A group of 15 foreign students, learners of Spanish, are coming to Conil during this school year. The teacher is looking for an agency that offers the best activity programme, with the most varied contents and attractive.

PROCESS

- 1) **Design a one-week activity programme.** Focus on the activities the visitors can do in your town. You have a model of an activity programme in Britain. But remember they come to Spain, not only to have fun but also to learn about our culture and language.
- 2) **Prepare the materials as a visual support.** For example, pictures, a powerpoint, or instead, if you are going to record in different places around Conil to show the activities and make them more real, make a plan of them.
- 3) **Practise the presentation,** your discourse (seem natural and attractive, not boring), pronunciation, body position and voice (be careful with the sound especially if you record it outside).
- 4) **Record!** With a camera or your mobile phone, but make sure you can save it in a pen later!
- 5) **Hand in!** Save your file in the folder SPEAKING-1stTERM of your classroom computer before the 11th of December.
